



## ADDRESS DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

### General

- **Commercial, Apartments, and RV/Mobile Home Parks:** Assigned address numbers shall be conspicuously placed immediately at the appropriate location on each property access point, building, and structure entrance.
- **All sizes are the minimum height required.**
- All addresses must be posted prior to building inspection final approval
- Addresses shall be displayed and visible from both directions of approaching vehicles
- The complete address shall be displayed on all corner buildings at a street intersection, for each side of building facing any street

- Numbers and letters shall be made of durable and clearly visible material. Paint is not an acceptable material
- Numbers and letters shall be of colors contrasting with the background to which they are attached
- Numbers and letters shall not exceed an aspect ratio of 6:1 (height to width)
- Numbers shall not be spelled

### Residential

- Assigned address numbers shall be conspicuously placed immediately at the appropriate location on each building, structure entrance, or at the property access point.
- <50 feet from curb requires 4" numbers displayed on the building
- >50 feet from the curb requires 4" numbers displayed a minimum of 36" above ground at the primary access point

### Apartments

- Entrance numbers shall be 12"
- Building numbers shall be 15"
- Apartment numbers ranges displayed below building numbers shall be 8"
- Apartment numbers ranges displayed on signage near the building shall be 2"
- Apartment numbers shall be 4" on outside entrances and 1" for interior hallway entrances
- Number ranges are required on buildings or signage

### Commercial

- Building numbers shall be 15"
- Suite space numbers shall be 6" on overhangs
- Tenant space numbers shall be 4" displayed by entrances
- Address range may be displayed in 12" numbers on the building
- If buildings within a commercial development are obscured from the primary street to which the development is addressed and from parking and access areas, directional signs shall be installed at each primary entryway
- A directional sign shall be clearly visible from all parking areas serving a building and shall have numbers displaying the address or range of addresses
- Directional signage numbers shall be 6"

### RV and Mobile Home Parks

- Entrance numbers shall be 12"
- Building numbers shall be 6"
- Space, directional signage, and internal street signage numbers shall be 4"
