## POOL RULES



- No person may use the pool unless it is officially open and the guards are on duty.
- Admission can be refused to all persons having any skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge, boils or other acute or obvious skin or body infection, or any communicable disease. Persons with excessive sunburn, open sores, or bandage of any kind will not be permitted in the pool.
- Running, rough play and personal conduct endangering the safety of self and others will not be permitted.
- NO SMOKING in the pool area. This is to be done only in designated area(s) outside of the pool area.
- Food and drinks must be kept in a designated area.
- No back dives, back flips, jumping towards the edge, turning around while jumping.
- No chewing gum in or around the pool area.
- No hanging on pool ropes and lane lines. They are for safety purposes, not for playing.
- No shoulder or back carries.
- All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
- Only pool employees may use the pool equipment.
- No Masks, Fins, Snorkels permitted in pool.
- No glass containers of any kind.
- No flotation devices of any kind, with the exception of U.S. Coast Guard Approved life vests.
- No children under 13 years of age without an Adult (18 years old).
- Patrons are prohibited in the lifeguard house and chemical rooms.
- No animals are allowed in the pool.
- No swimming in deep end, unless Lifeguard on stand declares open swim.
- Swimmers with life vests on are not allowed in deep end.
- No one is permitted to hang on the diving board.
- No swimmers permitted to play on or around the ladders.
- No swimmers are permitted to play on or around the step area.
- No diving of any kind in the shallow end of the pool.
- Pool staff will monitor the weather for lightning and heavy rain, in the event of such, patrons must leave the pool deck immediately.
- No prolonged breath holding or underwater swimming.
- All patrons must dress in appropriate (family-friendly) and clean/sanitary swimwear attire while using the pool; jeans are prohibited in the pool.
