# WHAT SERVICES DO THE VIPS PERFORM?

Depending on the level of training and experience, VIPS may perform a variety of duties that include, but are not limited to:

- Community patrol
- Traffic control
- School and neighborhood events
- Fingerprinting
- Crime prevention and safety events
- Fleet service assistance
- Child ID
- Dispose-A-Med events
- Special event assistance
- Mobile command post support
- Office and records section activities
- Vehicle ID number etching
- Police Department administrative support

# WHAT ARE THE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS?

## Applicants must:

- Be a United States citizen
- Be 21 years of age or older
- Possess a high school diploma or GED equivalency
- Maintain a valid drivers license
- Not have a felony conviction (misdemeanor convictions will be reviewed on an individual basis)
- Not have an dishonorable discharge from the U.S. Military
- Not have a conviction for DUI in the last five years
- Be willing to undertake, as required for various volunteer assignments, periodic drug screening and/or polygraph



## Program qualifications:

- Successfully pass a background investigation
- Possess or have access to computer and use e-mail
- Minimum eight hours per month time commitment
- Attend orientation training, specific to area of responsibility
- Field training for patrol duties
- Periodic in service training and proficiency reviews
