

MARANA ORDINANCE NO. 2017.010

RELATING TO MARANA REGIONAL AIRPORT; AUTHORIZING CAMPING AND PARKING OF MOTOR HOMES AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON THE AIRPORT DURING THE U.S. FLIGHT EXPO EVENT MAY 3-6, 2017; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Town has issued a special event permit to Geronimo Experimental Aircraft, LLC (“Geronimo”), pursuant to Marana Town Code Chapter 10-6, for Geronimo to hold the U.S. Flight Expo, an aviation trade show event (the “Event”), at the Marana Regional Airport, May 3-6, 2017; and

WHEREAS as a part of the Event, Geronimo has requested that participants be allowed to camp on the Airport and to park motor homes or recreational vehicles on the Airport; and

WHEREAS Marana Town Code Section 15-1-9(A)(2) prohibits camping on the Airport and Marana Town Code Section 15-4-3(C) prohibits parking motor homes or recreational vehicles on the Airport for more than two days and prohibits parking these vehicles in certain areas on the Airport; and

WHEREAS the Town Council finds that authorizing camping and the parking of motor homes and recreational vehicles on the Airport during the Event is in the best interests of the Town and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARANA, as follows:

SECTION 1. During the U.S. Flight Expo event, May 3-6, 2017, camping on the Airport and the parking of motor homes and recreational vehicles on the Airport are hereby permitted in areas approved and designated by the Airport Director, notwithstanding the provisions of Marana Town Code Section 15-1-9(A)(2) and Marana Town Code Section 15-4-3(C).

SECTION 2. The various town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Since it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Marana that this ordinance become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
