MARANA ORDINANCE NO. 2019.012

RELATING TO BUSINESS REGULATIONS; ADOPTING REVISIONS TO MARANA TOWN CODE TITLE 9 (BUSINESS REGULATIONS); ADDING NEW CHAPTER 9-1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS) AND RENUMBERING THE CHAPTERS THAT FOLLOW TO CONFORM; REPLACING EXISTING CHAPTER 9-1 (BUSINESS LICENSES) WITH NEW CHAPTER 9-2 (BUSINESS LICENSES); REPLACING EXISTING CHAPTER 9-2 (PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS AND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS) WITH NEW CHAPTER 9-3 (PEDDLERS); REPLACING EXISTING CHAPTER 9-3 (SWAP MEETS) WITH NEW CHAPTER 9-4 (SWAP MEETS); ADDING NEW CHAPTER 9-13 (MOBILE FOOD VENDORS); MODIFYING VARIOUS OTHER PROVISIONS; AND DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARANA, as follows:

Section 1. The amendments to the Marana Town Code Title 9 (Business Regulations), one paper copy and one electronic copy of which are on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Marana, Arizona, which was made a public record by and attached as Exhibit A to Resolution No. 2019-049 of the Town of Marana, Arizona, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part of this ordinance as if fully set out here.

Section 2. The following penalty clauses are included in the amendments to Marana Town Code Title 9 (Business Regulations):

9-1-7 Classification; enforcement; continuing violations

- A. Except as otherwise provided in this title, whenever in this title any act is prohibited or declared to be unlawful, or the doing of any act is required, or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, the violation of that provision is a civil infraction.
- B. This chapter may be enforced in any manner provided for by town ordinances and state laws.
- C. Each day any violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. The various town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, or motions and parts of ordinances, resolutions, or motions of the Council in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, effective as of the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day after its adoption.
